

# 2017 RESULTS AT LATIMER PRIMARY SCHOOL

## KEY STAGE 2 (YEAR 6 RESULTS)

Year 6 children take part in national 'SATs' tests in May. 2017 was the second year of new tests which reflect the updated National Curriculum and higher 'expected standards' for all pupils nationally.

'NATIONAL STANDARD' = new national expectation for primary pupils by end of KS2

'HIGH STANDARD' = achieved by pupils working consistently well above the new national expectation

There were 43 pupils in the Y6 2017 cohort at Latimer; 1 pupil = 2.3%

## KEY STAGE 1 RESULTS

Year 2 children take part in national assessments in reading, writing and maths during the summer term. As with Year 6, 2017 was the second year of a new test system and higher expectations for this year group nationally. There were 54 pupils in the Y2 2017 cohort at Latimer; 1 pupil = 1.9%

## PHONICS CHECK RESULTS 2017

Year 1 children continue to take a phonics test at the end of the summer term to check their basic reading skills are developing well. In 2017 children were expected to accurately decode a minimum of 32 real & pseudo-words out of a possible 40.

There were 49 pupils in the Y1 2017 cohort at Latimer; 1 pupil = 2%

Outcomes for all pupil groups were excellent. Pupils who did not meet the required standard made solid progress from their end of EYFS starting point.

Pupils who did not pass the check in Year 1 have to re-sit the test at the end of Year 2.

In 2017 we had 12 Y2 pupils who were required to retake the check. 1 pupil is dual registered at another school and did not take the check. Of the 11 pupils at Latimer, 10/11 met the required standard.
