

2018 RESULTS AT LATIMER PRIMARY SCHOOL

September 2018 version – NB national and school results are still provisional at this stage and therefore may change slightly. Awaiting 2018 results in some areas (should be available by December).

KEY STAGE 2 (YEAR 6 RESULTS)

Year 6 children take part in national 'SATs' tests in May. 2018 was the third year of new tests which reflect the updated National Curriculum and higher 'expected standards' for all pupils nationally.

'NATIONAL STANDARD' = new national expectation for primary pupils by end of KS2

'HIGH STANDARD' = achieved by pupils working consistently well above the new national expectation

There were 38 pupils in the Y6 2018 cohort at Latimer; 1 pupil = 2.6%

KEY STAGE 1 RESULTS

Year 2 children take part in national assessments in reading, writing and maths during the summer term. As with Year 6, 2018 was the third year of a new test system and higher expectations for this year group nationally.

There were 51 pupils in the Y2 2018 cohort at Latimer; 1 pupil = 2%

PHONICS CHECK RESULTS

Year 1 children continue to take a phonics test at the end of the summer term to check their basic reading skills are developing well. In 2018 children were expected to accurately decode a minimum of 32 real & pseudo-words out of a possible 40.

There were 46 pupils in the Y1 2018 cohort at Latimer; 1 pupil = 2.2%

Pupils who did not pass the check in Year 1 have to re-sit the test at the end of Year 2. 5 pupils from the 2018 cohort will have to retake the check at the end of Y2 (2019). In 2018 we had four Y2 pupils who retook the check:

EARLY YEARS FOUNDATION STAGE RESULTS

Pupils are assessed at the end of their first year of school in key areas of learning to determine whether they have reached 'good levels of development' for their age.
